Dr Kazalette Kiepiel graduated from Wits Medical School in 1983. Whilst working as a locum in London she qualified as a homoeopath. After her return to South Africa in 1990 she completed a course in Kinesiology. She uses a Quantum Xrroid Consciousness interface machine and Scenar medical device, invented by Russian scientists in the cold war space programme, diagnosing illnesses and Biopuncture, in which homoeopathic medicines are injected into acupuncture and trigger points. Her patients are also counseled on lifestyle changes, behaviour patterns and nutrition and for those with chronic illnesses, heavy metal poisoning and blocked arteries, chelation therapy is used. Although her practice is holistic drawing on an arsenal of complementary therapies, Kaz still uses conventional medical treatment where necessary as part of the whole... this is what she calls "responsibility medicine".
