



# 2019 Entrance/Scholarship Examination

## For entry into Grade 8 in 2020

To be considered for a place in Grade 8, every applicant is required to write the Entrance Examination which takes place at the school on Tuesday 7 May 2019. There will be a fun afternoon for **all** applicants and a sleepover for boarder applicants on Monday 6 May 2019.

## Epworth Scholarships

Epworth awards a limited number of major and minor academic, cultural and sporting scholarships which are tenable for five years provided standards are maintained.

### Academic Scholarships

These scholarships are based on the results of the Entrance Examination which all applicants are required to write. There is no application form for the academic scholarships - all children writing the Entrance Examination are automatically eligible for these scholarships.

The Entrance/Scholarship Examination consists of two papers:

- English
- Mathematics

These examinations are skills rather than content-based. They predominantly take into consideration the work covered in Grade 6.

**Examination Date: Tuesday 7 May 2019**

### Cultural Scholarships (Dance and Music)

These scholarships require a completed Cultural Scholarship application form (attached and available on the website: [www.epworth.co.za](http://www.epworth.co.za)) and an audition. Music requires a theory assessment which will be written immediately after the Entrance/Scholarship Exam (should your daughter meet the criteria).

**Music:** Parents will be contacted to set up an audition date and time.

**Dance:** The group dance audition will be held on **Tuesday 7 May 2019** after the examination.

### Sports Scholarships

These scholarships require a completed Sports Scholarship application form (attached and available on the website: [www.epworth.co.za](http://www.epworth.co.za)) and an interview (should your daughter meet the criteria and is shortlisted). Parents will be contacted to set up an interview date and time.
